


PLAT OF KELLY LAKE TOWNSITE

Know ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That Antonio Timpano and Selma Timpano, his wife, being the owners of the following described property lying and being in the County of St. Louis, State of Minnesota and described as follows to wit: All of the east one-half of the southeast one-quarter of Section 21, Township 57 North, Range 21 West of the 4th Principal Meridian according to the United States Government survey thereof, excepting a triangular area containing 0.082 acres now occupied by the Great Northern Railway Company's right-of-way, and being desirous of platting the same into Lots, Hocks, Streets, Avenues and Alleys, have caused the same to be surveyed and the annexed plat made in accordance with the statutes in such cases made and provided, Now therefore do we hereby ratify and confirm in all respects said survey and plat thereof as "KELLY LAKE TOWNSITE" and hereby dedicate to public use all Streets, Avenues and Alleys reserving the right to mine and remove any and all minerals and fossils existing in said streets, avenues and alleys but in such a manner as to not interfere with the public use of same.
