Know All Men By These Presents: That George C. Stone and Maria Louise Stone, his wife, being the owners of the following described property lying and being in the County of St. Louis and State of Minnesota to wit: All that part of Lot One (1) Section Eighteen (Sec. 18) lying South and West of the following described line, viz: Beginning at a point on the West line of said Section 18, distant South 320 feet from the Northwest Corner of said Section 18, and running thence East 500 feet to a point; thence South 320 feet to a point; thence South 45° East 551.54 feet to a point; thence East 432.36 feet to a point on the East line of said Lot 1; thence South 0° 10 1/4' East 79.1 feet to the Southeast corner of said Lot 1; all of Lots Two (2) and Four (4) Section Eighteen; All of Lot One (1) Section Nineteen (Sec. 19), all in Township Fifty-one North (T. 51 N.) of Range Fifteen (R. 15) West of the Fourth Principal Meridian according to the United States Government Survey thereof; All that part of Lot One (1) Section Thirteen (Sec. 13) lying south of the following described line, viz: Beginning at a point on the East line of said Section 13, distant South 520 feet from the Northeast corner of said Section 13 and running thence West 260 feet more or less to the shore line of Caribou Lake; all of Lots Eight (8), Five (5) and Six (6) Section Thirteen (Sec. 13), and Lots One (1), Two (2) and Three (3), Section Twenty-four (Sec. 24) all in Township Fifty-one North (T. 51 N.) of Range Sixteen (R. 16) West of the Fourth Principal Meridian, according to the United States Government survey thereof; and being desirous of platting the same into Lots, Blocks, and Roads, have caused the same to be surveyed, and the annexed plat thereof to be made, in accordance with the statutes in such case made and provided.
